#### QUALIFICATIONS AND SELECTION PROCEDURE:

The following will be considered in recommending teachers for summer school teaching positions:

Permanent and probationary District employees will be considered for summer school positions before other candidates are considered.

Basis for selection will be the following criteria priority order per the BTA contract (Article 26):

- (1) Possession of appropriate credentials and other state and federal accountability mandates.
- (2) Evidence of successful teaching experience at the grad(s) exed/or in the subjects for which the application is made.

Per the BTA Contract, Article 26.5, a summer school teacher may serve for up to three consecutive years. A unit member who has served as a summer school teacher for three consecutive years may be considered for reappointmentif there are not enough qualified applicants for the number of summer school positions
